



## Table Host Expectations

Thank you for your consideration to serve as a table host at The CARE Center's 2019 Stand Up For Kids luncheon, set for **Tuesday, September 10, 2019** at the Oklahoma City Golf & Country Club from 11:30am to 1pm.

Serving as a table host is a simple yet meaningful way to support the work of The CARE Center and our commitment to preventing child abuse through education and helping children find their voice and heal after abuse.

Table hosts are expected to fill their table of 10 seats. This is a great way to engage friends of the organization as well as individuals interested in learning more. Although there is no ticket for the event or cost to attend, we ask that each guest make a minimum contribution of \$100, and we ask that table hosts help communicate this in advance. All funds raised help support our prevention education programs.

This year, the event will feature guest speaker, Kevin McNeil, a former special victim's detective in Atlanta turned child abuse advocate, author, and teacher. Kevin is a child abuse survivor who used his personal and professional experiences to found The Twelve Project, a nonprofit organization working to educate the community and increase awareness on child abuse issues.
